Master's thesis colloquium presentation content

- 1. Working title with names of potential supervisors
- 2. Background of your topic short literature review
- 3. Aim and objectives
- 4. Indicative methodology
- 5. Rough schedule



Deadlines for thesis registration and submission

- The registration of final theses must take place at the latest by the end of the following semester in which the last examination was taken.
- If this master's thesis colloquium is your last examination (SoSe 2025) then your last day for registration of your thesis would be in WiSe 2025/26 or February 20, 2026.



Deadlines for thesis registration and submission

- The processing period of master's theses is up to 6 months. After submission, your examiners should submit their review of your thesis maximum 6 weeks after.
- Example: if you register on February 20, 2026 then you would have to hand in your master's thesis six months after on August 20, 2026. You should be able to defend anytime from six weeks after handing in your thesis on October 02, 2026.
